Mixing It Up Cocktail Party



he Whitehall Society of the Flagler Museum hosted Mixing It Up, a cocktail party celebrating the social spirit that has defined Whitehall. Festivities took place in Whitehall's beautiful Cocoanut Grove, where more than 120 guests were treated to thoughtfully crafted cocktails inspired by each era of Whitehall from Juicy Cocktail Bar. Drinks included the Widow's Kiss, a rich and aromatic cocktail that captures the essence of Gilded Age opulence; the Scofflaw, an illicit cocktail born in 1924 at the height of Prohibition; and the Grasshopper, a decadent dessert cocktail that soared in popularity during the 1960s. Partygoers enjoyed eats from Tropical Smokehouse and musical entertainment by the Lubben Brothers. A big thank you to everyone who joined in honoring the generations of guests who have laughed, toasted, and forged memories within the walls of Whitehall.

THE HENRY MORRISON FLAGLER MUSEUM

When it was completed in 1902, *Whitehall*, Henry Flagler's Gilded Age estate in Palm Beach, was hailed by the *New York Herald* as "more wonderful than any palace in Europe, grander and more magnificent than any other private dwelling in the world." Today, *Whitehall* is a National Historic Landmark and is open to the public as the Flagler Museum, featuring guided tours, changing exhibits, and special programs. The Museum is located at One Whitehall Way in Palm Beach.

The Museum is open from 10am until 5pm, Tuesday through Saturday, and noon until 5pm on Sunday. Admission is \$28 for adults, \$14 for ages 6-12, and children five and under are free. Guided tours, audio tours, printed selfguide brochures and the Flagler Museum Audio Tour app are all complimentary with Museum admission. Audio tours and self-guide brochures are available in English, Spanish, French, German and Portuguese.


