#### WHAT CAN PEOPLE EXPECT THIS YEAR AT THE KRAVIS CENTER GALA?

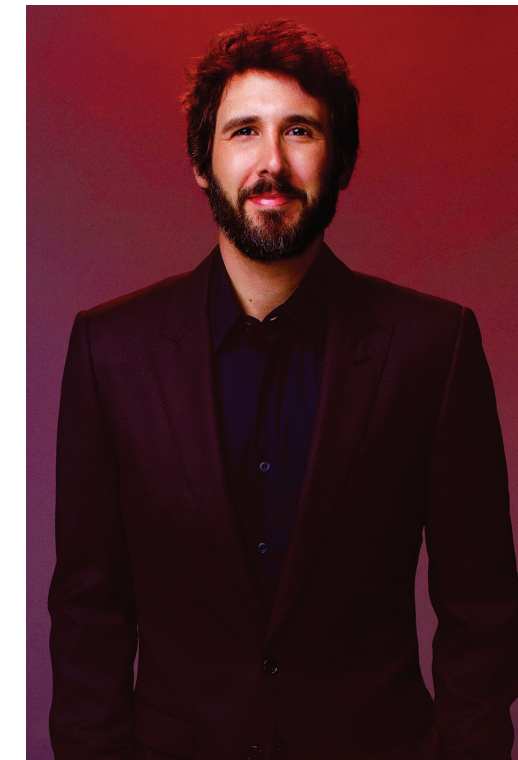
*Christine and Bob Stiller:*
