It is the most significant health and human services organization in its five-county region which includes Palm Beach, Martin, St. Lucie, Indian River and Okeechobee Counties. It is also the largest homelessness provider in its territory.

"I look forward to building a program that can sustain job placement for individuals with disabilities after graduation from GGI's Career Academy," said Chef Bell. "We provide a working environment through our
