The third annual *Gulfstream: Drive to Provide* took place at The Lake Pavilion in Downtown West Palm Beach. Hosted by **Gulfstream Porsche Club of America** in partnership with the **Ferrari Club of America, Palm Beach Chapter**, the fundraiser benefited **Gulfstream Goodwill Industries'** (GGI) homeless and residential programs.

"Tonight we come together not only to have a good time, but also to support a great cause," said **Michael Cowan**, Board Chairman for GGI. "Gulfstream Goodwill Industries is not about a handout; it's about a hand up for the people we serve — providing homeless services, employment and impactful assistance to open the next chapter of their lives."

More than 300 GGI supporters and car enthusiasts enjoyed a waterfront evening that included 80 rare and bespoke Porsches and Ferraris from private collections. Opera singer **Toni Rizzo** began the event with an a cappella version of *America the Beautiful*. Professional race car driver **Derrek Bell**, five-time winner of the 24-hour *Le Mans* race, was in attendance to judge the vehicles on display. Guests also enjoyed gourmet culinary creations, live entertainment, music by **D.J. Sage** and a silent and live auction that included fine jewelry, rare collectibles, once-in-a-lifetime vacations and exclusive experiences.

"Palm Beach County has a large population of homeless individuals that range from youth to seniors," said **Karen Davidson**, President and CEO of GGI. "Some are homeless because they lost their jobs, and others are battling substance abuse or mental illness. Seeing their despair and hopelessness is palpable. That is why this event is so important. It allows Gulfstream Goodwill to provide first, last and security payments for housing to people who have lost that basic human right.
